



2. Financial Report

Adjusted Bank Balance is \$51,171.

Right now, the church is sitting well financially. We have not had to take out a line of credit yet.

The Church is going to set up the Icon accounting program.

Gmail is now working for church emails. Email addresses haven't changed. Email addresses for the church will remain the same.

3. Old Business

a. Sim Sound equipment

Sim sound is coming Tuesday. They will be adding the new label and hook up the streaming in the sound booth.

b. HVAC Update

Vis hooked up the HVAC in the historical room and the pastor's office.

4. New Business

a. Carpet Cleaning

Hauser Chem-dry gave an estimate of \$1.858.12 to clean carpets and pews. The pews are the most expensive part. They could get it done in 1 or 2 days. Janet motioned to approve the entire quote of Hauser Chem-dry to clean carpets and pews at the price of \$1,858.12. 2nd by Matt Anderson. Motion carried.

- **b.** Tuck pointing needs to be done around the bell tower. Water is leaking in. We will wait until we hear back from the Organ costs before we make decisions on fixing the tuck pointing. We will need congregational approval to have this fixed.
- **c.** Organ went out in late June. Dobson out of Lake City, Iowa, has agreed to come down to look at. He will come this week to look at. They will charge us mileage, \$100 for coming, pay for time here, and then mileage back. It will cost around \$700-\$1,000 for them to look at it.
- **d.** The dishwasher at the parsonage has quit working. The pastor will look into costs for a dishwasher and get back to the council on prices.
- **e.** Council member Zach Haugerud is leaving for Australia for about 9 months and maybe more. We will need to fill his position on the council. If anybody would like to fill out his term, please contact the office or the pastor.

Email scams are going around again, please be careful!!

Just a reminder: Pastor Kurt, Josh, Sam or anyone else from Greenfield Church *will never* ask you for a gift card. Please ALWAYS call Pastor or the office when in doubt.

How Email Scams Work...

<u>Impersonation:</u> The scammer pretends to be someone you trust, like your Pastor or a government official to gain your trust.

<u>Urgency:</u> They often create a sense of urgency, claiming the request is timesensitive and needs immediate action.



Gift Card Request: The core of the scam is the request to purchase gift cards,.

Money Transfer: Scammers then ask for the card numbers and PINS, which allow them to immediately redeem the cards for cash or spend the balance online.

Red Flags to Watch Out For: If the email creates a sense of urgency and pressure to act quickly it's a strong indication of a scam. Many scam emails contain errors in grammar and spelling. Check the sender's email address carefully. Scammers often spoof email addresses to make it look like they are coming from a legitimate source.

If you suspect a scam what to do?

Do not respond. Do not click on any links in the email. Verify by calling Pastor or the office.
